WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, § 17-1006 requires certain individuals doing business as a junk dealer or scrap metal processor in the state of Maryland be licensed to engage in said business and

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, § 17-1003 requires that a county or municipal governing body in the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held shall designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit to receive records in accordance with the statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion made, duly seconded and carried, it is this ____ day of _____, 2010, **RESOLVED** by the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland, as follows:

1. That the Charles County Sheriff's Office is hereby designated as the Primary Law Enforcement Unit for Charles County in regards to the enforcement of the regulations as set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article § 17-1001 et al;
2. That the Charles County Sheriff's Office shall receive records in accordance with § 17-1011 (b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.

Finally, **IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect on the ____ day of _____, 2010, and apply immediately upon the signatures of the County Commissioners of Charles County, Maryland.
